Homes built before 1978 may contain lead based paint. Keep me healthy by removing lead based paint safely.



Some imported candy, pottery, jewelry, and vinyl mini blinds may contain lead. Keep me safe by being aware of dangerous products



Lead dust from old paint or contaminated soil can settle on window sills, floors and even my toys. Help me wash my hands and toys often.



Some moms and dads work with lead. Wash your hands after work & keep contaminated clothing and equipment far away from little ones like me.



Lead poisoning can cause me to have growth, development, learning and behavior problems when I get older. Ask my doctor to test me for lead.



Feed me healthy foods rich in vitamin C, iron & calcium. This helps keep lead out of my blood.
